The Cumberland Island Inn and Suites in St. Mary's presents a warm and inviting atmosphere for this year's reunion. It's location is five minutes from Kings Bay Submarine Base and a short distance from St. Mary's waterfront.

The Cumberland Inn does not have a restaurant so some of our events will be away from our hotel site. The Inn does provide a deluxe continental breakfast bar with Belgian waffles, between 0630 to 0930. Coffee is always on. There is a café within walking distance that is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Our Thursday evening reception will be at the hotel site in the courtyard, our Friday events will be ashore. For this reason we need volunteers to act as drivers for car pools.

This is an outstanding property where you will certainly enjoy your stay. However, it is two stories (without an elevator) and buildings surround a courtyard. There are exterior stairs. The hotel offers spacious and well appointed accommodations with all the guest amenities you may want to make your stay comfortable. There are microwaves, refrigerators, coffee makers, irons and ironing boards, large screen TV's with cable, free wireless and high-speed internet access in all the rooms. Also available is a business center, laundry room, fitness room, and an outdoor pool. 85% of the rooms are non-smoking.

Rooms are offered in King or 2 Queen beds at the special rate of \$71.00 per night. Suites are available at \$89.00 per night. All rooms are plus 13% tax. Fully handicap rooms are available. If

needed, please inform the desk when you make your reservation. No wheel chairs are available. Our special rate extends from 25 September through 8 October.

Hotel Reservations: Reunion attendees must make their hotel reservations directly with the hotel's registration office by calling the listed number in the left column heading. Specify that your reservation is for USNTC Bainbridge Association to receive our special room rate of \$71.00 plus tax per night or suite rate of \$89.00 plus tax per night. There is a 13% tax rate.

Reserve your Room Now !!! Your reservation will require a deposit equaling one night's room charge or a valid credit card. Charges will be applied to your card only at the time you check in or you fail to check in and fail to cancel your reservation on time.

Reservations will be held only until your scheduled check in time, not for the entire length of your stay. If you fail to check in as scheduled, you cannot be guaranteed a sleeping room. If you have not canceled your reservation and have not checked in by 6:00 pm on the first day of your reservation, the charge for your first night's stay will be applied to your credit card.

Guest Parking: There is plenty of parking on the grounds. If you are driving a motor home please inform the desk when you make your reservation so they can advise you where to park.

Shuttle Service: There is no shuttle service available.
